

General rules of conduct	4.71%	3.17%
Risk of contamination	4.12 %	3.66%

0.8% of all regular audits led to a sanction procedure because of deviation. The amount of sanction cases has fallen by **11%** compared to the previous year.


Since 2014, QS-certified producers have been able to have checked the requirements of the Regional-fenster e.V. in the QS audit.
